found in the shadow of the VICTORY GARDEN

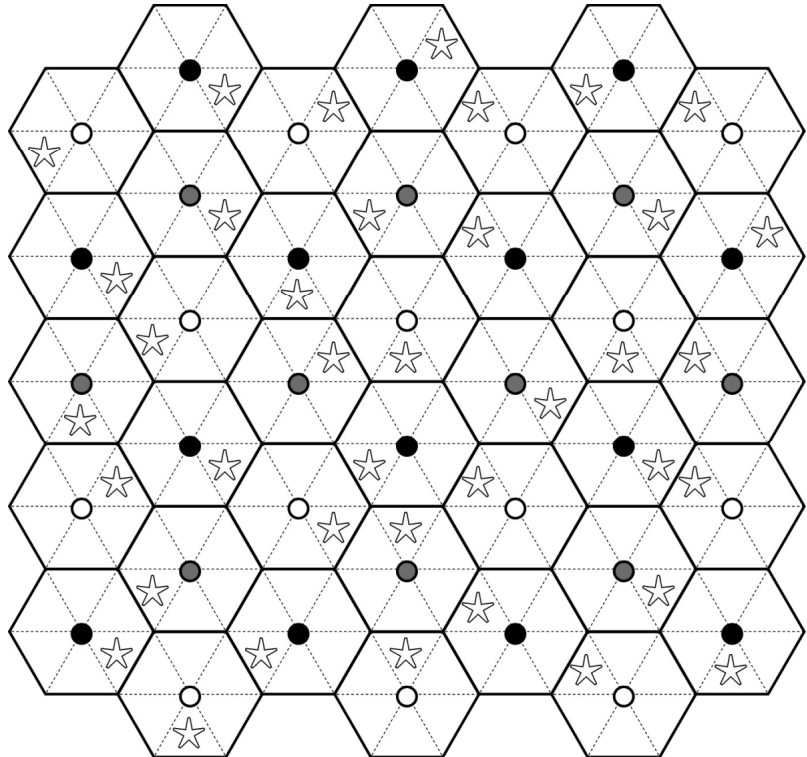
Leisurely strolling up and down through the garden, I stopped to look at the stars.
