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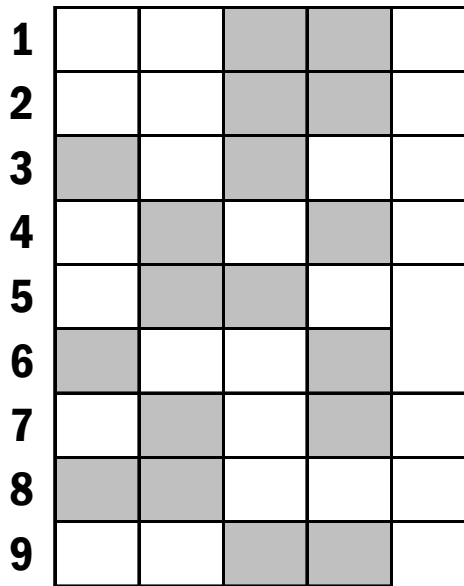

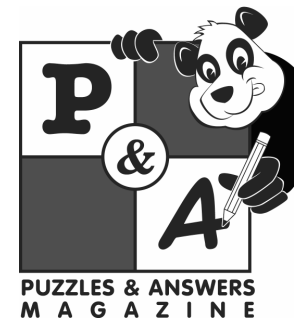

P&A Magazine is an inventive magazine...and you know what they say about building a better mousetrap!

Seven new mousetraps are on the market, each distinguished by certain qualities. Can you determine each trap's qualities?

Grid for mousetrap qualities with columns: Gray, Made of copper, Has a handle, Spins, Comfort grip, Non-toxic, Dishwasher-safe, Better than a mousetrap. Rows: RatFixer, Like Snap!, Icy-Stop-U, Urn-Trap, Steel Eye, Eek!-Senic, Catalisk.

- 1. Each quality is possessed by exactly two traps.
2. Exactly four traps have exactly two qualities; of the other three traps, Urn-Trap has more qualities than Like Snap!, which has more qualities than Eek!-Senic.
3. No two traps have the same set of qualities.
4. The two traps that spin also have comfort grips. Neither is the Icy-Stop-U.
5. The two traps that are non-toxic are Eek!-Senic and a trap that has a handle.
6. The two traps made of copper are actually both better than actual mousetraps.
7. Both of the gray items have more qualities than the Catalisk.
8. Like Snap! isn't made of copper.
9. The Catalisk is dishwasher safe.
10. Neither Icy-Stop-U or RatFixer have any qualities in common with Urn-Trap.
11. One of the inventors noted that all seven traps have eight letters in their name.
